Malaysian Candidates:

1. SPM / SPMV: Pass with a minimum of 5 credits with a mandatory credit in > Bahasa Malaysia > Mathematic (Modern or Additional) > General Science; OR Biology; OR Chemistry and pass in Biology; OR Physics and pass in Biology

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- 2. Credit in 2 other subjects
- 3. Pass in English

International Candidates:

- 1. Pass O Levels or equivalent with a minimum Grade C in the following mandatory subjects
 - > Mathematics (Additional or Modern)
 - > General Science
 - > Biology; OR

Chemistry and pass in Biology

Physics and pass in Biology.

- 2. A pass in IELTS with an overall Band Score of minimum 5.5; OR TOEFL with an overall Band Score of minimum 550 if medium of instruction is not English.
- 3. Able to converse in Bahasa Malaysia.

HEALTH STATUS:

- 1. All candidates must be certified medically fit by a registered medical practitioner within one month from commencement of the nursing programme.
- 2. Candidates with any of the following medical conditions cannot be admitted into the programme such as:
 - HIV/AIDS - Hepatitis B
 - Mental health disorders - Hepatitis C
 - Epilepsy - Color blindness
- 3. Candidates must not have any physical disabilities or impaired senses that hinder nursing dexterity.
- 4. Pregnancy is not allowed throughout the course.
